Sterilization Drying Protocol Checklist
<ul> <li>□ Drying Cycle Importance</li> <li>• Ensure packs are completely dry before handling.</li> <li>• Wet packs can cause wicking and contamination.</li> <li>• Drying time varies with humidity and temperature.</li> </ul>
□ Visual Inspection • Look for crinkling, transparency or softness. • Check for punctures or tears at edges and seams.
<ul> <li>□ Handing Guidelines</li> <li>• Handle packs no more than 3-4 times.</li> <li>• Use Transfer clear bin to minimize contact.</li> <li>• Repackage and re-sterilize any damaged packs</li> </ul>

□ Event –Related Sterility Assurance
 Store sterilized packs in clean clear bin.

· Avoid unnecessary handling before clinical use

· Always handle sterile pouches with clean gloves-never with bare hands

· Always use clean gloves when setting up trays in treatment rooms
